4Rkids Early Childhood Iowa offers preschool scholarships to Adair, Dallas, Madison, and Warren County children whose families meet income guidelines. Our program is offered through funding provided by the State of Iowa. The purpose of this funding is to increase school readiness of our children by increasing access to quality preschool programs.

# 2024/2025 Preschool Tuition Assistance/Scholarship Guidelines

- Children must reside in the service area.
- ➤ Children must have turned three by September 15, 2024, to be eligible.
- ➤ 4-year-olds must enroll in at least ten hours of programming per week at a cooperating preschool which meets quality standards.
- Eligibility is based on family size and gross annual income. A sliding scale is used to determine the amount of the award. The maximum award, based on ten hours of programming, will not exceed 90% of the tuition or \$225 per month. The family is responsible for the difference in tuition and for any enrollment or late fees, or withdrawing without paying fees owed to the program. **Program reimbursement is for a half-day rate**.
- The award will remain in place until the end of the school year if the child's attendance is 90% or above. The preschool provider will notify you if your child falls below 90%. (On-going attendance problems may result in loss of the scholarship.)
- > Children eligible to enroll in a state and/or federally funded program (Head Start, Shared Visions) must participate in that program before being able to apply for this scholarship. Statewide Voluntary Preschool will be encouraged to be filled before providing preschool tuition assistance. If other assistance is available through a preschool, agency, or business, the lowest tuition rate will be utilized.
- > If you are applying for more than one child in your family, a separate application must be submitted for each child.
- > If the child switches preschools, the funds will follow the child if the preschool meets the scholarship program guidelines.
- > Notify preschool enrichment project when there is a change in income, contact information.
- Responsibility for registration fees, co-pays, and late fees.

Final decisions rest ultimately with the 4Rkids Early Childhood Iowa Board. Payments will be made directly to the preschool on behalf of the family. Funding is contingent upon state award and contract. **Applications will be processed after July 1, 2024, pending state funding and local contract award.** Families will be notified of the award at that time. ### **Guidelines:**

The scholarships are for families living in *Adair*, *Dallas*, *Madison*, *and Warren* County who are *not* eligible for tuition scholarships through other programs. Early Childhood Iowa scholarships are not to replace other funding. Applications will be accepted until budgeted funds are expended.

- Preschools must meet the guidelines set by the 4Rkid's Early Childhood Iowa Board to receive funds.
- Parents are expected to pay a portion of the child's tuition based on a *sliding fee scale*. Tuition scholarships are confidential between the preschool enrichment coordinator, the family, and the preschool. Parents are responsible for co-payment directly to the program. If the co-payment is not paid, the non-payment preschool policy will be enforced.
- The scholarship application must be received by ISU Extension and Outreach Dallas County by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month for tuition to be considered for that month of service.
- The family and the preschool will be notified of the outcome of the application.
- Children in foster care are automatically eligible for tuition assistance at 90%. An application must be submitted; however, no income verification is required.
- Scholarships do not pay for wrap-around childcare, meals, or transportation. Scholarship coverage September-May.
